Thanksgiving Pick-up Menu
(\$44.50 per person/minimum 6 people): roast turkey with mushroom sausage stuffing, herbed gravy, pomegranate "Pama"-cranberry sauce, root veggie mashers; salad with romaine, watercress, endive and maple dressing; pumpkin/sweet potato/pecan soufflé; caramelized onions, red carrots and haricot vert; rolls with butter; choice of chocolate/bourbon/pecan pie, sweet potato pie, pumpkin pie, Yakima pear and apple pie.

Order 48 hours in advance. Pick up by 11:30 a.m. Thanksgiving Day.
